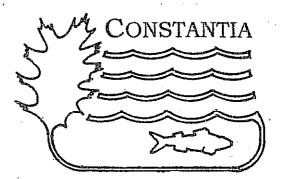

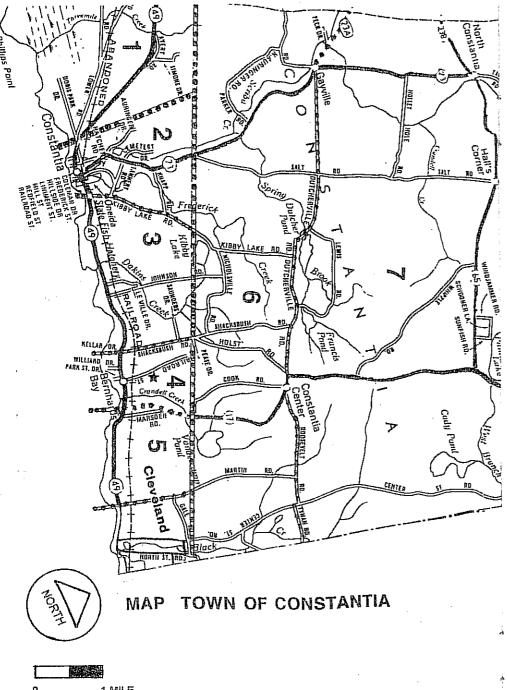
INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT
