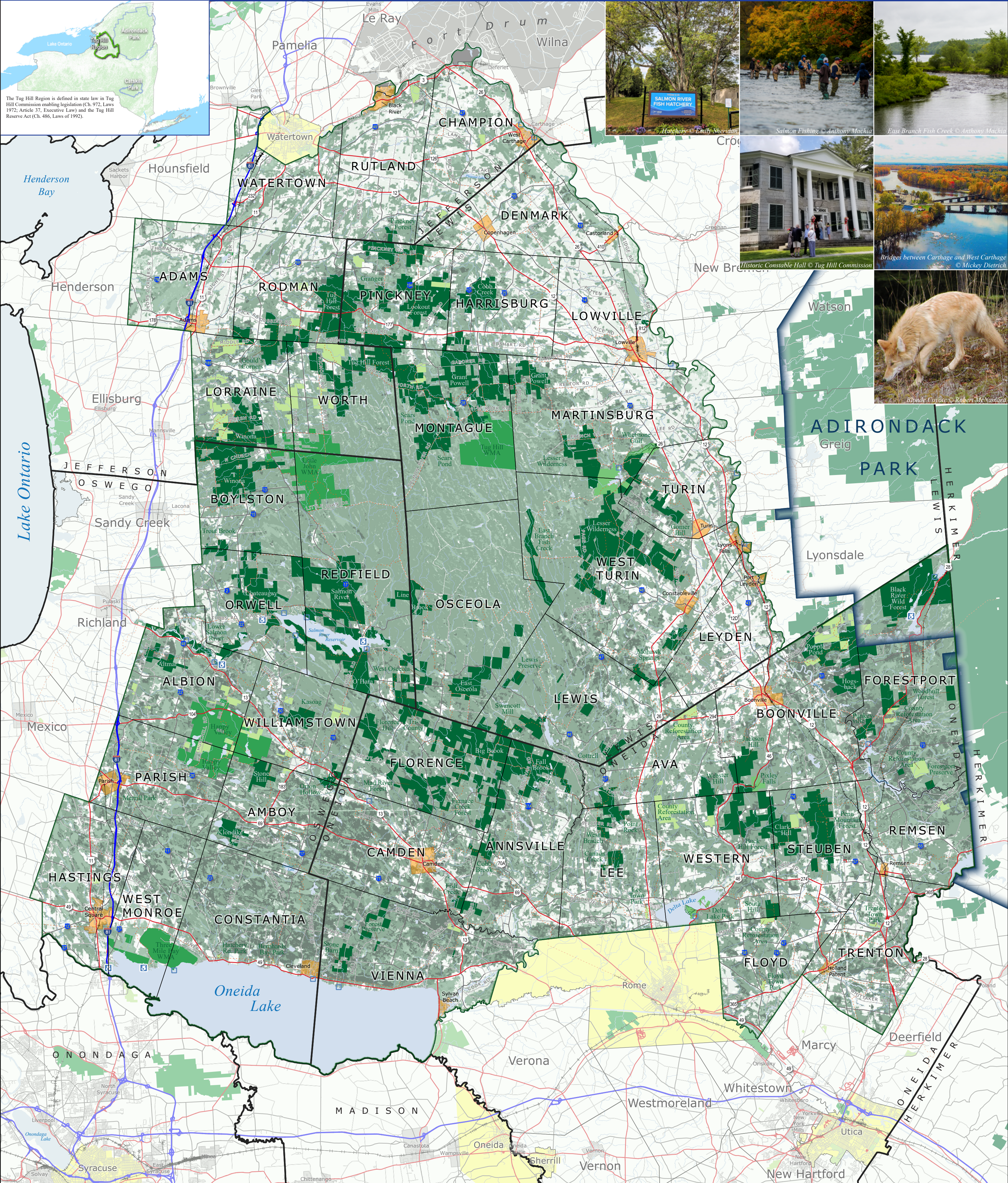


# Tug Hill Region of New York State
