Grants: How To Start

Getting your municipality prepared:

- Create your "Strategic Plan"
- Register for System of Awards Management (SAM)
- Register online with grant funding agencies
- ▶ Be aware of applications and their deadlines

Creating Your Strategic Plan

- ▶ What are your projects?
 - Project priorities
- Create a funding plan
- ▶ Gain public input

SAM Registration

- System of Awards Management
- Obtain your Unique Entity Identifier (UEI)
- Make sure to update yearly

Grant Funding Agency Registration

- Register with Grants.gov (Federal)
- Register with Grants Gateway (State)
- Other registrations such as FEMA, DOJ, etc.

- Consolidated Funding Application (CFA)
- ▶ Grants Gateway (State Application Portal)
- NYS Homes andCommunity Renewal(CDBG)

- Department of Transportation (DOT)
- NYS Unified Court System
- NYS EducationDepartment

Federal Grants

- Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)
- Department of Justice (DOJ)
- Department of Homeland Security (DHS)
- Federal Department of Transportation (DOT)

Income Surveys

Applications & Deadlines

- Maintain a "Grant Calendar"
- Keep an application checklist
- Know your deadlines

Administering the Grant

- Grant funding entity will notify you of the award
- Contract
 - Make sure to respond promptly!



Administration Follow-Up

- Maintain awareness of deadlines
- Keep an electronic record of all details
 - Have a physical record as well
- Try to create/maintain a relationship with someone who works for the grant funding entity

"What if we don't get the grant?"

There's still options!

Didn't Get The Grant.. Now What?

- Review where it went wrong
- Project prioritization
- Review funding plan
- Have strong supporting documents
- Reapply

Review: Where Did We Go Wrong?

- Ask funding entity for a debrief
 - Application scoring
 - Ask questions
 - "What did we do wrong, what can we do better"

Project Prioritization

- Is this project still a priority in your community?
 - Should we reapply?
- Produce a new priority list
 - Reassess wants and needs "wish list"
- Change your definition of "No". Your ask may not align with the grant funding entity's desires

Review Funding Plan

- Create an updated cost assessment
- Check matching funds requirements
- Verify your supporting documents
