Woodsman's Field Days

Enabling Statute: AML Article 18 Section 225

The council shall work with wood-using manufacturers to increase the economic contributions and employment opportunities related to the practice of forestry and manufacture of wood products in New York State.

The council shall give priority to:

- 1) increasing private investment in working forests;
- 2) maintaining access to working and family forests;
- 3) **coordinating policy and permitting issues** with state agencies, academia and the private sector;
- 4) working to **improve public understanding** of and appreciation for forestry and forest products;
- 5) and increasing export and market opportunities for New York forest products.




